Key Scripture: "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation..." — Hebrews 2:3

Introduction:

"...that ye should be married to another, even to Him who is raised from the dead..." (Romans 7:4) Salvation brings us into a personal relationship with Jesus.

Salvation is the ultimate miracle — greater than healing, prosperity, or deliverance. It cost the blood of Jesus. Never take your salvation lightly — it reflects God's greatest act of love and power.
