

Sermon Notes: "He That Hath..."

I. Introduction

In this message, we explore the principle from Mark 4:24-25, 'He that hath, to him shall be given...' demonstrating how God empowers us to steward and multiply what He gives.

II. Scripture Reading

Mark 4:24-25 (KJV) – “And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear... For he that hath, to him shall be given...”

III. Key Themes

- A. Power to Gain: God equips us with spiritual and practical power (Deut. 8:18).
- B. Seasons of Growth: Preparation (0–25 yrs), Implementation (25–50 yrs), Mentorship (50+ yrs).
- C. Distinct Sources: Righteous provision vs. questionable gain (Prov. 10:22; Jer. 17:11).

IV. Main Points

1. God's Enabling Power

- a. Wisdom to plan (James 1:5).
- b. Favor and grace to give (Phil. 4:19).
- c. Freedom from poverty (Psalm 112:3).

2. Principles of Multiplication

- a. Faithful stewardship (Luke 16:10).
- b. Generosity unlocks increase (2 Corinthians 9:6).
- c. Long-term trust vs. quick schemes.

3. Practical Applications

- a. Identify and develop your gifts.
- b. Invest time, talent, and treasure.
- c. Accountability through mentorship.

V. Reflection Questions

- What resources has God already entrusted to you?
- In which 'season' are you currently, and how can you maximize it?
- What steps can you take this week to sow into Kingdom purposes?
