### Introduction

- The anointing represents the \*\*power and presence of God\*\*.

- All believers are called into ministry in some form.

- The anointing distinguishes and empowers us for impact.

### Effect 1: The Anointing Introduces Strength

- Strengthens delivery in ministry (Psalm 89:21).
- Transforms ordinary believers into powerful ministers (Acts 4:13).
- Empowers boldness and authority through divine influence.

### Effect 2: The Anointing Protects from Deception

- Grants \*\*discernment\*\*, spiritual insight (Matthew 23:24).
- Guards against spiritual blindness and hypocrisy.
- Helps believers \*\*navigate life wisely\*\* and stay faithful.

### Effect 3: The Anointing Breaks Yokes and Bondages
- Frees us from sin, fear, doubt, and generational curses.
- Leads to spiritual **freedom and victory** (Isaiah 10:27).
- Breakthroughs happen in anointing services through spiritual power.
### Effect 4: The Anointing Helps Locate Blessings
- Positions us to find and receive divine resources and opportunities.
- Without the anointing, its hard to walk in Gods purpose.
- Elisha received a double portion from Elijah, leading to double miracles (2 Kings 2:9-10).

### How to Receive the Anointing
- **Spending time with Jesus** through the Word (John 1:1).
- **Soaking messages**, reading books from anointed leaders.
- **Servanthood**: serving under anointed men/women of God (e.g., Elisha under Elijah, Joshua
under Moses).

- Every believer must desire and pray for the anointing.

- The anointing transforms character and brings Gods presence into every area of life.
- Let us long for the anointingnot worldly things like wealth or fame.
